

	<p>Books provided in the book corner and investigation area relating to the world, different countries, space and travel for children to explore independently.</p> <p>Writing Provide opportunities for the children to write or use letters to put together their name.</p>
Maths	<p>Number Counting planets and rockets. Comparing groups of aliens (more/less). Using planet numbers to order correctly. Singing daily number rhymes/songs i.e., Zoom, Zoom, Zoom, 5 little aliens etc</p> <p>Numerical Patterns Creating patterns on their own alien underpants. Sorting and matching shapes. Play the space themed subitising game.</p> <p>Shape, Space and Measure Using shapes to create an alien world. Learning about capacity with containers and cauldrons, making magic potions. Size ordering planets- big and small.</p>
Understanding the World	<p>Exploring different cultural celebrations, such as Chinese New Year. Learning about other people's countries and how some people migrate to a different country.</p> <p>The Natural World Make boats to float or sink. Winter walk collecting natural resources. Exploring the seasonal changes of Winter and Spring comparing it to Autumn.</p>
Topic	<p>Land and sea Countries Earth and Moon Travel</p>
Music	<p>Counting songs and action rhymes. We will learn one traditional nursery rhyme weekly: children will bring it home each Friday with their library book.</p>

<p>Development</p>	<p>Using large construction resources to vehicles to travel i.e., cars/trains/planes/boats/rocket etc. Use balls to throw asteroids into hoops. Using construction blocks to build different planets and made-up worlds. Chalk drawing a planet earth outside. Use the outside wooden equipment to travel to different countries and planets. Provide pots/buckets in the sand pit for children to make alien worlds.</p> <p>Fine Motor Use tongs to move golden coins in sand. Drawing with a 'magic crayon', practising mark making.</p>

Express feelings of magical characters and their emotions.</p> <p>Managing Self Explore healthy food from around the world.</p> <p>Building Relationships Practising sharing resources to make a spaceship. Work as a group to 'roll the planet' taking turns to roll the ball.</p>
