Books provided in the book corner and investigation area relating to the world, different countries, space and travel for children to explore independently.</p> <p>Writing Provide opportunities for the children to write their initial or more letters from their name.</p>
Maths	<p>Number Children will start to identify numbers to 5 and begin to count over 5.</p> <p>They will identify which group of objects has more or fewer and share small quantities beginning to understand the concept of sharing.</p> <p>Shape, Space and Measure Learning to identify objects according to their length/heights and starting to order them accordingly. Start using the language of capacity by making porridge.</p>
Understanding the World	<p>Exploring different cultural celebrations, such as Chinese New Year. Learning about other people's countries and how some people migrate to a different country.</p> <p>The Natural World Make boats to float or sink. Winter walk collecting natural resources. Exploring the seasonal changes of Winter and Spring comparing it to Autumn.</p>
