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Curriculum map Spring 2 – Year 2

Subject Area	Content
English	<p>Spoken Language: To ask relevant questions to extend their understanding and knowledge. To communicate ideas in complete sentences. To give well-structured descriptions, explanations and narratives for different purposes.</p> <p>Reading: To apply phonetical knowledge to read aloud and understand the meaning of unfamiliar words. To discuss the sequence of events in books and discuss favourite words and phrases.</p> <p>Writing: To compose sentences using a range of sentence structures. To write own version of a traditional tale, using a clear structure. To begin to re-read sentences to check for sense.</p> <p>Spelling, vocabulary, grammar, and punctuation: To use subordination and co-ordination to link events, cause and effect. To use expanded noun phrases for description and specification. To use progressive form of verbs in the present and past tense. To use capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks to demarcate sentences.</p>
Maths	<p>As a school we are following the new Herts for Learning Maths scheme. This term we are focusing on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Multiplication - Multiples and Repeated Addition, Number of Groups, Group Size and Product, Multiplication Problem Solving Division - Sharing and Grouping Problems including Remainders - Fraction equivalences <p>Recap of learning completed so far</p>
Science	<p>Working scientifically:</p> <p>Asking relevant questions and using different types of scientific enquiries to answer them.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Making systematic and careful observations and, where appropriate, taking accurate measurements using standard units, using a range of equipment. -Gathering, recording, classifying and presenting data in a variety of ways to help in answering questions.



	<p>-Recording and reporting findings using simple scientific language, drawings, labelled diagrams, keys, bar charts, and tables.</p> <p>Science content: Animals Including Humans Pupils will be taught to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults - find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air) - describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.
ICT	<p>Effective searching: This term our Purple Mash topic is effective searching. The children will be learning about search engines and will be learning key vocabulary around web pages and websites. At the end of the unit the children will create information leaflets on the computers explaining effective searching.</p>
Humanities	<p>History: The children will be learning about the life and the national and international achievements of both Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole.</p>
Music	<p>Charanga: This term our song is 'zoom time'.</p>
PE	<p>This term the children will have the chance to take part in a PE Programme called 'Premier League Primary Stars' which is run by sports coaches at Watford FC. This programme is designed to develop the children's physical skills in sport as well as their social, emotional and thinking skills.</p> <p>Target Games - pupils develop their understanding of the principles of defending and attacking for target games. They develop the skills of throwing, rolling and striking towards a target and are given opportunities to select and apply the appropriate action for the target considering the size and distance of the challenge. They will apply their skills individually, in pairs and in small groups and begin to organise and self-manage their own activities. They will understand the importance of abiding by rules to keep themselves and others safe, learn how to score points and use simple tactics.</p>
Spanish	<p>The children will continue to develop their knowledge and understanding of Spanish through the Modern Foreign Language teacher.</p>
Art	<p>The children will receive an Art lesson each week from our specialist Art teacher, which will focus on different art element each week. The children will also learn about Art and Design Technology through</p>

	cross curricular lessons with their class teachers. For example, the children will be creating a 3d habitat for Giraffes.
PSHE	Following the programme 'Jigsaw', Year 2 will be focusing on the theme of 'Healthy Me'. This will focus on discussions and task around being healthy, being relaxed, medicine safety and healthy eating.
RE	This term we are focusing on Easter. The children will be learning about the Easter story and why Easter is important for Christians.
